Dr. Beason recognized Dr. Yelmarthi to present an informational item for the College of Engineering admission requirements. Currently, the admission requirements for the College of Engineering are 3.0 high school GPA, ACT composite of 20 and ACT math subscore of 22 for engineering and computer science majors not including engineering technology. Students who do not meet the admission requirements are admitted into the College of Interdisciplinary Studies. If the students were admitted into the College of Engineering, staff would have the opportunity to provide support. The College Engineering administration proposes to change the admission requirements for engineering and computer science majors from a 3.00 GPA, 20 ACT composite and 22 ACT Math subscore to 2.85 GPA, 17 ACT composite and 17 ACT Math subscore. No changes are proposed for engineering technology. The request is for these changes to be implement effective for fall 2024. Discussion was held.
