Proceedings:

Chair Kristine Craven called the Administrative Council meeting to order at 3:33 p.m. Sandra Smith-Andrews motioned to approve the agenda for September 4, 2024. Holly Mills seconded. Motion APPROVED.

Mary Lou Fornehed motioned to approve the April 3, 2024 minutes. Andrew Donadio seconded. Motion APPROVED.

New Participation in Malign Foreign Talent Recruitment Programs Policy No. 790 was presented as an information only item due to being approved out-of-cycle. Charmian Leong explained the policy is to prohibit covered individuals who receive funding from federal research agencies from participating in malign foreign talent recruitment programs. Covered individuals are Tennessee Tech faculty, staff, and students who receive federal research funding. This policy was written to comply with the provisions in the CHIPS and Science Act regarding research security and undue foreign influence, particularly sections 10631 and 10632 of the Act. These sections prohibit federal research agencies from issuing research awards to anyone participating in a malign foreign talent recruitment program. Since May 2024, the National Science Foundation (NSF) has required individuals designated as senior or key personnel on a proposal to certify they are not participating in malign foreign talent recruitment programs. Individuals participating in malign foreign talent recruitment programs are not eligible to serve as senior or key personnel on an NSF proposal or award made after May 20, 2024.

The Department of Defense released a policy that stated participation in a malign foreign talent recruitment program is a risk factor that must be mitigated before they will release funds to award recipients. Under this policy, effective August 9, 2024, the Department of Defense (DoD) will deny funding if the proposing research institution does not have a policy prohibiting participation in malign foreign talent recruitment programs. This DoD policy was the main reason Tennessee Tech needed a malign foreign talent recruitment policy in place by August 9, 2024, which necessitated the policy being approved out-of-cycle. This was to ensure Tennessee Tech remained eligible for Department of Defense funding as well as demonstrating a commitment to research integrity and federal, state, and sponsor requirements.
