

# Minutes from the Supreme Court | January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024

## Regular Meeting

The Supreme Court of the Student Government Association of Tennessee Tech met at 6:51pm on January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023, in the Multipurpose Room of the Roaden University Center. Chief Justice Bryson Lee was present and presiding. Chief Justice Lee took the roll, and a quorum was established. The minutes dated November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023, were read by Attorney General Tidwell, and they stand approved. The agenda attached as Appendix A was adopted as the orders of the day.

Chief Justice Lee noted that this meeting was originally scheduled for January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023, but was rescheduled due to the weather of the previous week.

The floor was opened to discussion on the meeting schedule for the spring semester. After discussion, Chief Justice Lee entertained adopting the following schedule of meeting dates all to occur after the adjournment of the Student Citation Appeals Committee in the Center for Student Engagement Conference Room: February 6<sup>th</sup>, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, March 5<sup>th</sup>, March 21<sup>st</sup>, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, and April 18<sup>th</sup>. **SO MOVED** by Justice Martin. Seconded. The motion was **ADOPTED** with **6 AYES** and **0 NAYs**.

Chief Justice Lee opened the floor for announcements. Chief Justice Lee made an announcement noting that Justice LeMay had resigned from the Supreme Court. Attorney General Tidwell announced that the Judiciary Selection Committee had been reformed to fill the two vacancies on the Court. Attorney General Tidwell

continued and asked Justices to inform potential candidates to reach out to the chair of the Judiciary Selection Committee, SGA President Hale.

In accordance with the orders of the day, Chief Justice Lee declared the Supreme Court **ADJOURNED** until February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, after the adjournment of the Student Citation Appeals Committee without objection at 7:28pm.
